Believe it or not we are a month into the new school year! The kids have transitioned well and we are having a great time getting to know each other.

Last month we learned about going to school, apples, circles and the letter "A". We also learned our classroom rules and a few songs. Ask your child to sing the "Speckled Frog Song" and what sound the letter "A" makes to see if they connect it to an alligator.

This month we will focus on Fall, Pumpkins, Orange, Triangles and the letters B and C.

We will be going to the Pumpkin Patch at The Farm in Snohomish on Tuesday, October 18th. We will not have regular classes that day and will meet at the Farm at 9:45 am. You will need to provide transportation for you child or work out a carpool.
